

Communication Language and Literacy

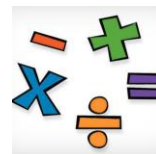

Year 1 will learn how to spell the days of the week and know when to use capital letters (names and places). Year 2 will learn to investigate homophones and use them in sentences. (bye, buy, by).

All children will develop their independence in checking their work, especially punctuation and spellings. Some children will learn when to use a or an in front of a word. Year 1 will learn how to read compound words and Year 2 will learn how to spell compound words.

Traditional tales-The children will recall and write traditional tales.

Information texts- The children will learn about information texts and their features. They will use information texts to ask questions about a topic and to find an answer. They will make a class glossary of topic words. The children will begin to think about how to group their information into headings, sub headings or paragraphs. They will produce their own information page about Knights and Castles.



Solving, Reasoning and Numeracy

Year 1- The mathematicians will secure their knowledge in place value, becoming even more confident with numbers to 100. They will move onto money, making different amounts and giving change. They will end the term by learning to tell and draw the time on clocks for o'clock and half past.

Year 2- The mathematicians will continue telling the time to 5 minute intervals, drawing the time on clocks and comparing intervals of times. They will read and answer questions about data in tables and pictograms. They will end the year exploring positions and directions.



Creative Development

Art and design- The children will design and create a shield. They will also work as a team to plan and make a castle using junk modelling, thinking carefully about the different features of a castle and how materials can be cut and joined.

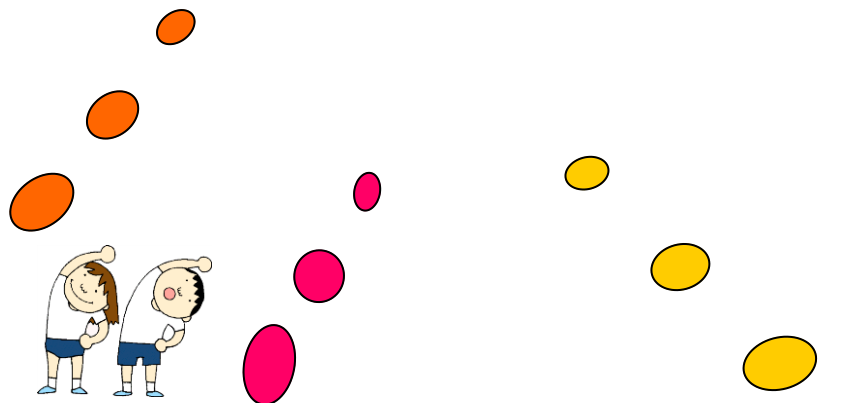
Music- The musicians will reflect, rewind and replay with Mrs Stamper.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

Science – Living things and their habitats. The scientists will learn about food chains.

Topic- 'Knights and Castles'. The children will spend this term learning about castles. They will learn about the features of a castle and what life is like in castles. They will learn about job roles for people who live in castles. The children will learn about weapons used for defence.

Computing- The children will discover coding. They will look at and create their own coding.
