Last year we had: a Warmington Bonfire cake stall, two Quiz Nights, a personalized Christmas Card fundraiser, two Christmas Wreath Nights, a Christmas Disco, and the Summer Fete raising over £5000 in the process - not bad for a small school. The school will use this money to purchase a new audio/visual system for the hall. With funds raised, the PFA also puts on a summer picnic for the children, provides refreshments for parents on Sports Day, purchases bookbags for Hedgehogs and Year 5 Red Kites, provides leavers gifts for the Year 6 Red Kites, and contributes funds toward special class trips and events to reduce the cost to parents.

You can be as involved as you like, with no pressure to do more than you are able to. Many of those involved work, and we understand the pressures of time only too well. Meetings are held only 5 times a year, approximately one per half term. An agenda is sent via email in advance and minutes follow afterward.
